



## Sightseeing Information

### Yangon Private Full Day Tour by Gray Line

Yangon, Myanmar

Tour colonial and religious Yangon, including a ride on the antiquated Circular Railway

Duration of tour: 8 hours



#### oThe Tour

Hear about colonial architecture, religious buildings and parks and feel the real Yangon. First stop is the Sule Paya, a Burmese stupa located in the heart of downtown. After that intermingle with residents in one of the colourful local markets before heading to the iconic Strand Hotel for a drink in the shadows of Rudyard Kipling, George Orwell and Somerset Maugham. Take a look at the enormous reclining Chauk Htat Gyi Buddha before a lunch drawn from popular cuisines in Burma such as Kachin, Shan and Rakhine. In the afternoon hop on the famous circular train for a 30- to 45-minute ride. Enjoy the slow pace of this antique railway, used by locals, monks and vendors. The train stops right behind Bogyoke Aung San Market in the centre of Yangon. There will be time to explore the city's largest selection of Burmese handicrafts before heading back to the hotel.

#### oIncludes

Round-trip transfers and sightseeing by air-conditioned vehicle, English speaking guide, entrances to Sule Paya, Chauk Htat Gyi Reclining Buddha, Circular Railway train ride (not air-conditioned), one drink at the Strand Hotel, local lunch

Dress in Myanmar is conservative, particularly when visiting religious sites. Lightweight, long-sleeved clothing is appropriate. Skirts, dresses, and shorts should be knee-length or below.
